## Finishing off the Year

We've had 131 Students come through our program this year, 82 of those called our program home, participating all of the way through playoffs. We were able to provide meals, coaching, encouragement and a safe space every week for a consistent group of over 80 students. Above, you'll see the picture of the students that had flawless attendance (we buy them jerseys to reward their dedication). Over 20% of our students are so dedicated, they never miss a week. We're blown away by that statistic, and so grateful we get to have these young people in our lives. 131 students heard about Jesus, over 80 of them consistently while being kept off the street. We are excited about this and what God has in store for these young people!

Playoffs were incredible this year, giving us some amazing action. We got to watch multiple series go to game 7. Saw comebacks, upsets and very raw emotions. After all was said and done we were happy to grant the Bridge City Chiefs and the Saskatoon Tigers the championships in their respective leagues (pictured of the back)! We also retired 11 players this year as they have now aged out of our program. Three of them had been a part of our program for over a decade which is over half of their lifetime!

The last thing we will do this year for our program is a trip to Winnipeg to play off the winners of their league in a national championship! The Tigers get to go with a few pick-ups from other teams as we see who will take home the National Cup! We are still looking for a bit funding to help us finish off our year and this trip! ## A Call to Prayer

Teaching kids life lessons is doable. Showing them some skills to get by in the world is nothing. Helping hurting families that battle consistently with abuse and addiction is a whole other concept. You can feel hope in a student's positive life decisions until you drop them off at an unstable house at the end of the night. This is the reality. This pain is hard to heal. Habits can change, brains plagued by FASD and abuse cannot. It takes a miracle just to maintain space for hope in these kids' lives, let alone our own.

I need to lean on something supernatural. I need to believe that if God can raise people from the dead, He can bring healing to any pain. I need supernatural help to stop myself from feeling hopeless. This is where you come in. We need prayer. Either to give us hope, for wisdom, or complete healing in these complicated situations.

We need your prayers.
